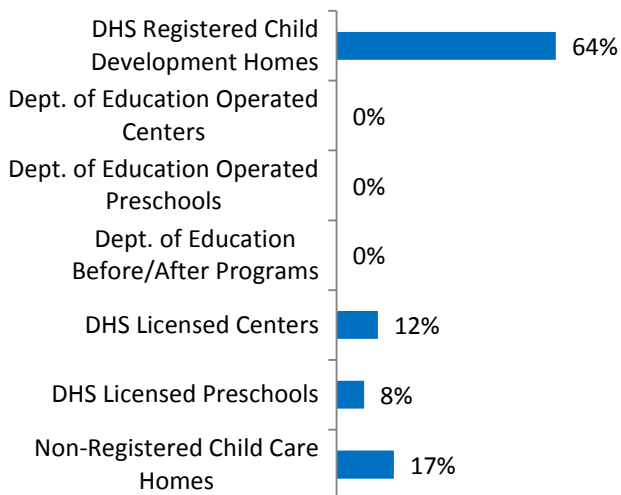

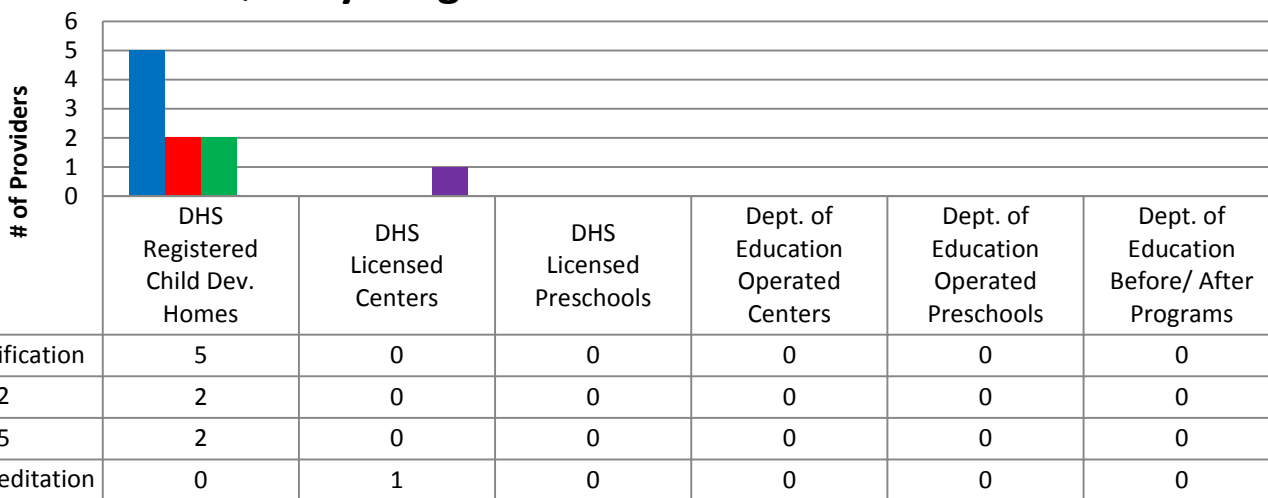

- 9% of their income before taxes, if their child was in a registered home

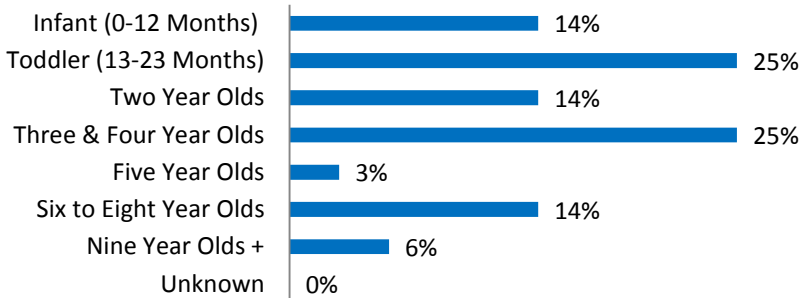

### Range of Preschool Tuition Rates per month - by age

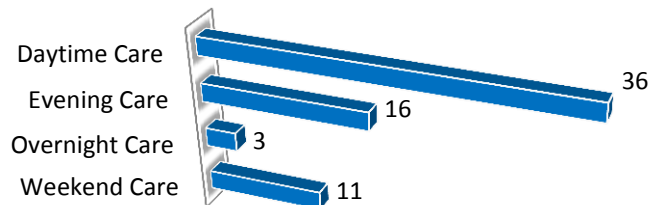
