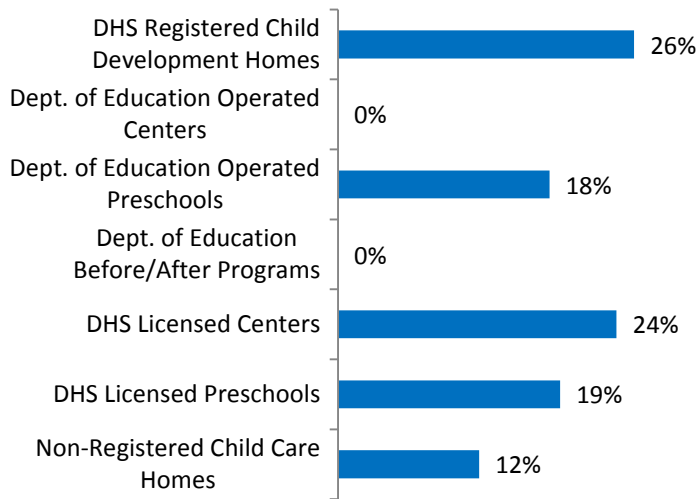

- 11% of their income before taxes, if their child was in a licensed center

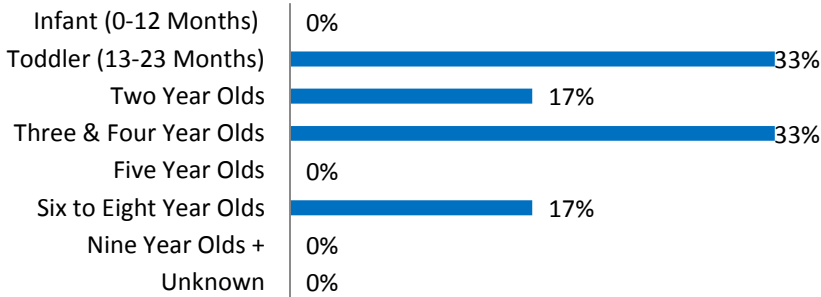
