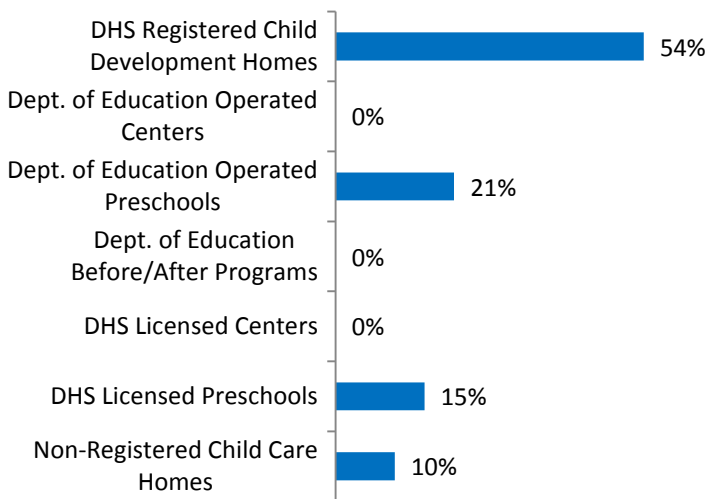

- N/A % of their income before taxes, if their child was in a licensed center

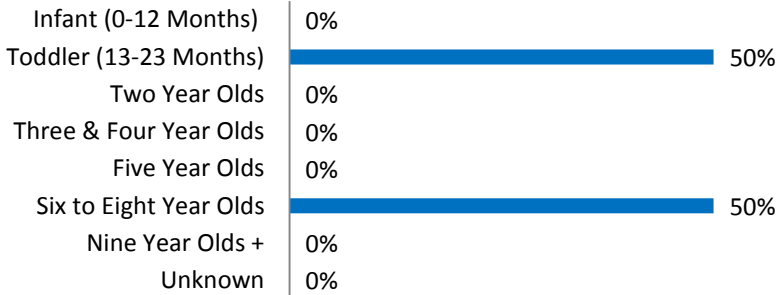
