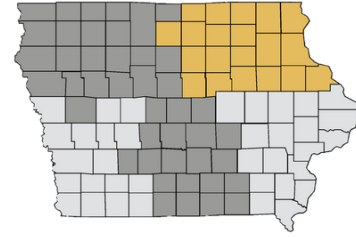


CCR&R OF NE IOWA



CCR&R of Northeast Iowa receives funding through the Department of Human Services (DHS) from state and federal appropriations and from local Early Childhood Iowa (ECI) areas. These funds provide child care providers, families, and communities the services they need to enhance the upbringing of Iowa's children. These services include consultation visits, trainings and quality incentives. With more funding, CCR&R of Northeast Iowa can improve the unmet child care needs in the area.

In Fiscal Year 2022, our top priorities included supporting programs that were re-opening or struggling to stay open while also engaging in the recruitment of new programs.
