9% of their income before taxes, if their child was in a registered home

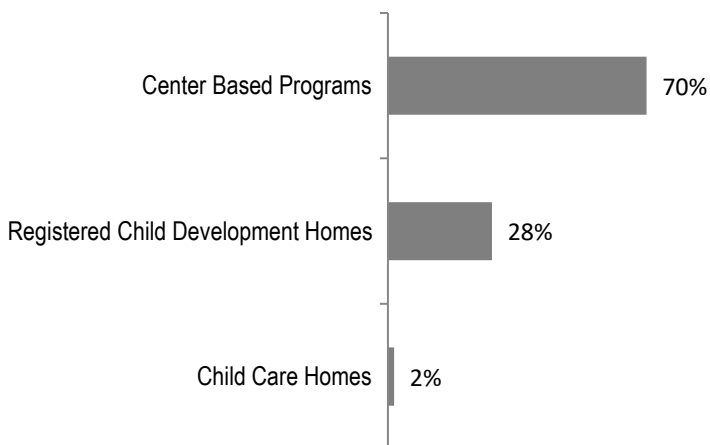
10% of their income before taxes, if their child was in a licensed center

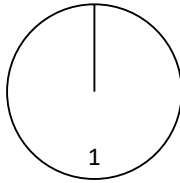

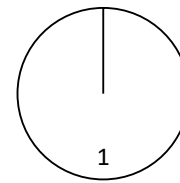
